




Chivato is an on again, off again hotel located on the point of a cliff. It is one of the nicest locations you will find in the mid-Baja area. It has been through a series of owners and we keep hoping that someone will come along and make the investment in both time and money to bring this back to the resort that it once was. All ocean front rooms have large windows overlooking the sea and sunken "conversation" pits with fireplaces. There is a patio in front of each room with a small green lawn. Located on a bluff, there are several rock stairways that will take you down to the sandy beach.

There are many fine homes located on either side of the hotel and I have seen several King Airs parked there.

You can camp on the beach adjacent to the parking area and various water sport "toys" can be rented on the beach.

One of the best "shelling" beaches in Baja is located here. It starts at the parking area and goes south to and past the 31 end of the strip. You will find a nice shell, pick it up, and find a nicer one. You will toss the first one and keep the second one. This goes on and on.

The wind can be very strong here however, if you like to shell, and I know that all men like to shell, this is the place for you.
