

Use 31 for both takeoff and landing whenever possible. With the hotel at the 13 end, there is a lot of pedestrian traffic and the dust can be a large problem. There is a run up pad on the end of 31. It can also be a little loose on the 31 end. Watch for children crossing mid-field.
